The Council of Architecture is a statutory body of Government of India constituted under the Architects Act, 1972 and regulates the field of Architectural Education in the country. The Council accords approval to all architectural institutions for imparting 5-year B.Arch. degree course in the country by assessing their standards of education.


The Council has been conducting National Aptitude Test in Architecture (NATA) for admission to 1st year of 5-year B.Arch. degree at various institutions in the country for past several years. About 80,000 students appeared for NATA in 2016.

For the academic session 2017-2018, the Council has decided to conduct NATA 2017 as a **one day test** (in two parts) all over the country. About 1 lakh students are expected to appear for NATA in 2017. **The 3rd Sunday of April (16.04.2017)** has been identified by the Council as the date to conduct NATA for admission to Architecture course.

This is for your kind information so as to ensure there is no clash with other exams related to 10+2 level candidates.
