Sub.: Eligibility criteria for admission to 1st year of 5-year B,Arch. degree course - reg.

Dear Sir,

I have to refer to your letter dated 07.02.2017 on the above subject and to inform you that as per the Council of Architecture Minimum Standards of Architectural Education; 1983, no candidate, with less than 50% marks in aggregate, shall be admitted to the architecture course unless he/she has passed an examination at the end of the new 10+2 scheme of Senior School Certificate Examination or equivalent with Mathematics as subjects of examination at the 10+2 level.

\*\*\*\*

Further, candidates who have passed 10+3 Diplomas with subject of Mathematics, duly recognised by Central/State Governments with minimum 50% aggregate marks are also eligible for admission to B.Arch. course.

It may also be informed that admission to 1<sup>st</sup> year of Architecture course shall be made subject to the candidates passing the NATA or any specially designed aptitude test in Architecture conducted by the competent authority.

The Institutions shall follow the reservation policy of respective Government in granting relaxation in percentage of marks obtained in the qualifying examination for admission in the institutions.
