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Important circular for aspiring candidates

Instructions/Steps to be followed for taking part in vacant seats in Govt. / Grant-in-Aid/ University managed Government (Unaided) and Self finance Institutes (SFI) for M.E, / M. Tech./ M. Pharm. courses for year 2020-21

In concurrence to the advertisement published by this committee regarding modalities for vacant seats admission process. The institute wise vacant seats are displayed on committee website which includes vacant seats in Govt./GIA/University Managed Government (Un-aided) institutes and SFI institutes. The detail process for participating in both type of institute is as follows.

For Vacant seats in Govt. /GIA /University managed Government (Unaided) institutes:

The candidate willing to take part in vacant seats in Gov/GIA/University managed Government (Unaided) institute shall have to give online consent from their login ID on website **www.gujacpc.nic.in** between **7/11/2020 and 8/11/2020**. The candidate has to login to his account at www.gujacpc.nic.in and **Click here to Proceed link available at the dashboard**, the candidate will be diverted to Consent screen, here the candidate has to give his consent as **YES** or **NO** by clicking Yes, the candidate will be able to participate in the referred Round of admission. After giving consent, the candidate has proceed for choice filling in their login ID between **7/11/2020 and 8/11/20**. **It is compulsory to give consent and fill choices again, to become eligible for this round of vacant seats in Govt./GIA/University managed Government (Unaided) institutes.**

The consent once given cannot be changed later on, which may please be noted. If you have given consent as NO, in such case you will not be able to participate in Round 3 (for Vacant seats in Gov/GIA institutes) of the admission process

As per schedule already announced, the allotment for this will be declared online on **11/11/2020** and candidates who have to pay fee, shall pay the same through Online payment mode between **11/11/2020 to 12/11/2020**. **Candidates who are already in merit list of ACPC shall only be allowed to take part in this vacant seats in GOV/GIA/University managed Government (Unaided) institutes.** Moreover, candidates who do not give online consent and not fill choices as stated above, shall not be considered during this online round of admission process.

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For Vacant seats in Self Financed Institutes (SFI)

The Vacant seats in **Self Finance Institutes (SFI)** shall be filled as per provisions of rule 20 of prevailing notification. Accordingly aspiring candidates fulfilling eligibility criteria of notification for admission to ME/M. Tech/M. Pharm courses dated 30.6.2020 issued by Education department Government of Gujarat (available on committee's website) shall have to contact the concerned self-finance institute of his choice between **7-11-2020 to 30-11-2020** for vacant seats admission process at the institute of his choice and preference. The candidate has to submit his application with all requisite documents at the concerned institution within the prescribed time limit.

The concerned self-finance institute shall process the filling up of vacant seats among eligible candidates by displaying vacant seats details on its website, counseling schedule, preparing common intra-se merit list between **7 /11/2020 to 30/11/2020** and complete the entire process latest by **30/11/2020** in accordance with all provisions of prevailing admission notifications of Government of Gujarat for admission to ME /M. Tech/M. Pharm. courses. The Merit list will be based on valid GATE/GPAT score/marks or Common Entrance Test (CET) marks, duly obtained by candidate or any such merit based scheme as declared by the concerned institution, giving priority to GATE/GPAT qualified candidates and CET appeared candidates in line with rule 11 B of prevailing notification

The candidate can approach any number of institute of his choice, as per his eligibility (See Appendix I of prevailing admission rules) in the concerned course, but at each institute he has to apply separately at the respective institute on the available vacant seats.

All are required to follow central / state government guidelines and protocols regarding the COVID-19 pandemic.

Note: The candidates are advised to carry all original documents for verification at the time of counseling at SFI institute level.
